

Not illustrated. 1910 Excerpt: . . . work has been done under Dr. Simon Flexner, the hospital and isolation building were opened on Monday, October 17th. It is the first hospital designed for the specific purpose of medical research. Its location makes it possible that the buildings are lighted from all sides, for even the third basement, overlooking the river in the rear, is at least twenty-five feet above the street level. The hospital building consists of eleven floors, four of which are provided for patients. Each ward opens directly on to an open loggia or roof, so that all the beds in the ward may be wheeled out at once, and the patients kept out of doors all the year round should it prove desirable. Perhaps the best characterization of the individuality of the building is to say that a very large proportion of the area devoted to patients is out of doors. On the entrance floor of the hospital building are placed the offices of the director, chief of the medical staff, head nurse, superintendent, etc., besides (in the river end) quarters for the medical staff. The second floor is devoted to the nurses, head nurses and superintendent, each being provided with a sitting room, bedroom and bath; night nurses having their sleeping rooms cut off by isolating corridors and double doors. This floor has an ample dining room and a sitting room. This story constitutes in fact an apartment for nurses, and, as all stairs are cut off by...
