Excerpt: . . . 11 ADDITIONAL BENEFITS A total disability rating based on IU can result in eligibility for additional benefits for a veterans dependents and survivors. Educational benefits for the veterans spouse and eligible children are available under the Survivors and Dependents Educational Assistance Program (title 38, United States Code, chapter 35). The Ci-vilian Health and Medical Program of the Department of Veterans Affairs (CHAMPVA) provides reimbursement to eligible dependents for most medical ex-penses, provided that they are not also eligible for health care benefits provided by the Department of Defense. To be eligible for both of these benefits, the veterans IU determination must be considered permanent. Permanency for eligibility to chap-ter 35 and CHAMPVA requires that there not be a future examination scheduled. APPLICATION PROCESS In most cases, to be considered for IU benefits, a veteran must apply. However, in the Norris case mentioned earlier, the court held that a veteran need not apply for IU for a claim for IU to...
