Barley and oats were grown more extensively, the former showing an increase of 128,500 acres, and the latter one of 173,000 acres; the area under oats was the largest recorded since 1904. Of the pulse crops, beans were reduced by 25,000 acres and peas increased by 18,000 acres. The area under potatoes showed an increase of 80,000 acres, or nearly one-fifth, and was about 10 per cent greater than the highest acreage previously recorded. There was an increase of 34,000 acres in the area under turnips and swedes; the area under mangolds increased by nearly 11,000 acres. The area of clover and rotation grasses was 90,000 acres less than in 1910, nearly all the reduction being in that, reserved for hay; in all the hay area was reduced by nearly 180,000 acres. From an agricultural point of view the year was characterized by the large number...
